The latest update to the Comdata<sup>®</sup>Health system includes the following items:

- New Web Service: Stop Payment
- Adding Activation Date to Virtual Card Details
- Adding Date/Time Stamp to the Funding File Creating Business Intelligence Reports by

#### New Web Service: Stop Payment (available 7/9)

This new web service request, Stop Payment, allows clients to cancel payment on a virtual card if the provider chooses a traditional payment instead. Based on the funding model (pre-card issuance or post-authorization) and the current card status, the requested card will be blocked permanently or temporarily until authorization is dropped after 7 days. In the case of a temporary block (there are outstanding authorizations), the card amount is returned after 7 days if the authorization drops. If the authorization settles, the payment is processed as normal.

This feature works with card numbers or tokens.

### $\mathbf{Y}$ Adding Activation Date to Virtual Card Details (available 7/14)

For clients using an inventory of virtual cards, the card activation date differs from the initial date a card was assigned to inventory. This enhancement creates two separate values, Creation Date and Activation Date, within the card listing table used in PS14 bulk card assignment and inventory.

## $\mathbf{Y}$ Adding Date/Time Stamp to the Funding File (available 7/14)

To ensure manual adjustments to the funding file (MT001 or MT002) are recorded accurately, this enhancement adds a date/time stamp associated with a manual adjustment to the file.

### └ Creating BI Reports by Corp Code (release date pending)

Many Comdata Health clients maintain multiple plan sponsor accounts under one corporate code (Corp Code). To allow these clients to pull a Business Intelligence (BI) report covering all their accounts, this enhancement adds the capability to generate BI reports by Corp Code.
